CHARITABLE PURPOSES

The charitable purposes of the Association are the advancement of education and the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science by providing a website, information, educational resources, talks and exhibitions about the Holocaust and the refugee experience to the general public, students and school children and by learning from testimonies of Holocaust survivors and refugees from Nazi persecution who have settled in Scotland.

REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES

Our Gathering The Voices Presentation Team had another busy and successful year in 2022, but due to covid restrictions many, but not all, of our talks have been virtual instead of in-person. Since Gathering the Voices was established in 2014 we have presented to over 15,000 students at over 210 events and 110 locations from Aberdeen and Oban in the north, Edinburgh, Greater Glasgow, and London in the south. Overseas locations have included Yad Vashem in Israel and Landshut in Germany. Over 17,000 students and 22,000 adults have viewed our exhibition. Our website has been accessed by over 42,000 visitors and our Twitter account attracted over 32,000 views in the last 20 months (all figures to end of 2022). We look forward to exciting developments in 2023 with the launch of Marion's Journey Educational Computer Game and the opportunity to present in person.

TRUSTEES REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES

The Trustees received reimbursement of expenses of £605 during the year (2021: £1,229).

RESERVES

All of the Trust funds are unrestricted general funds and are used by the Trustees to further the work being carried out in accordance with the above charitable purposes.
